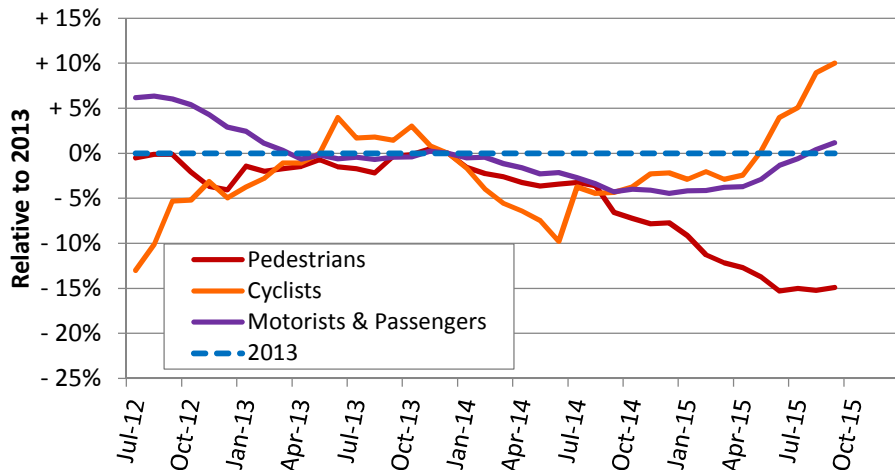

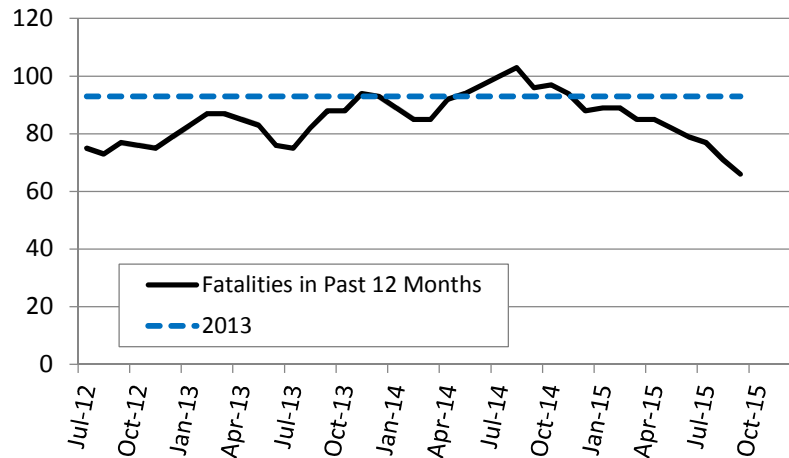

Injuries & Fatalities in Previous 12 Months (vs. 2013)

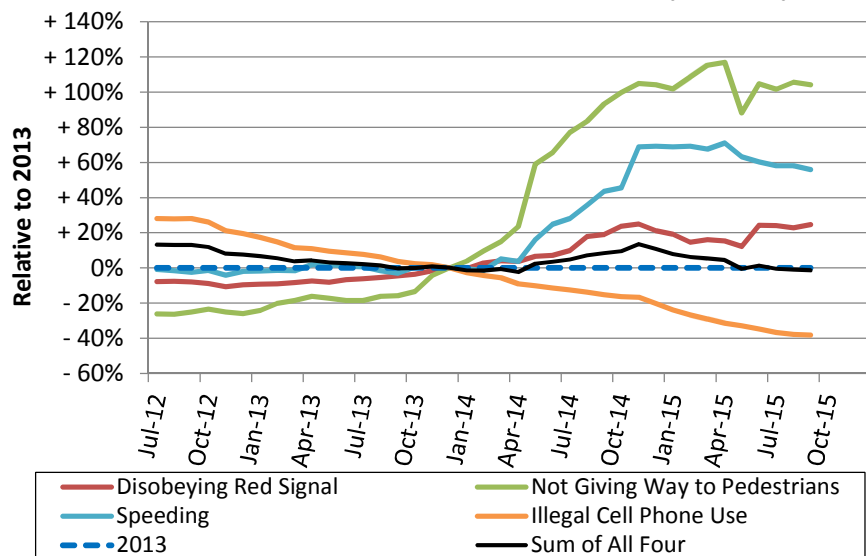


Total Traffic Fatalities in Previous 12 Months

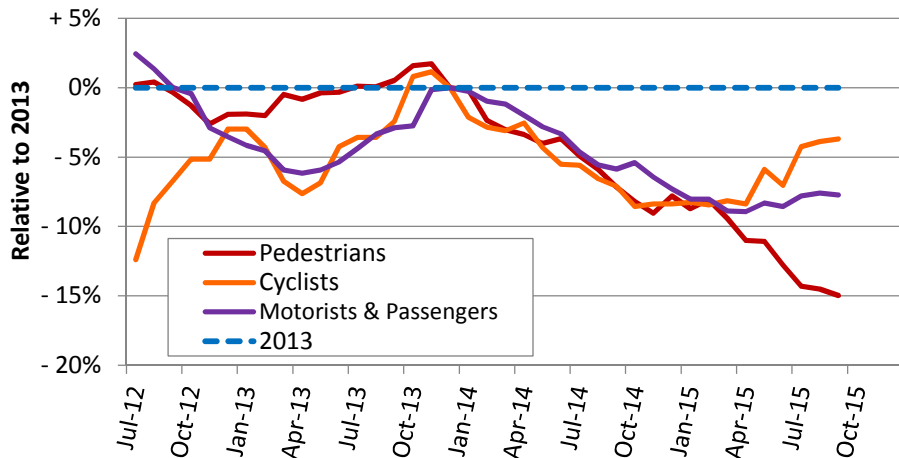

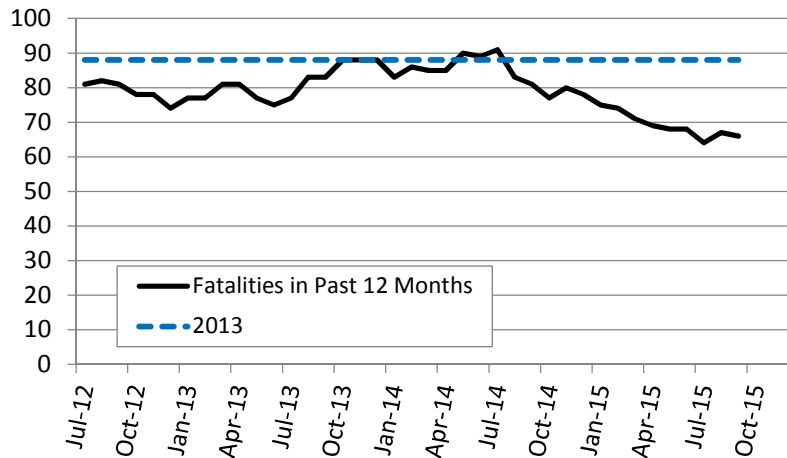

Injuries & Fatalities in Previous 12 Months (vs. 2013)

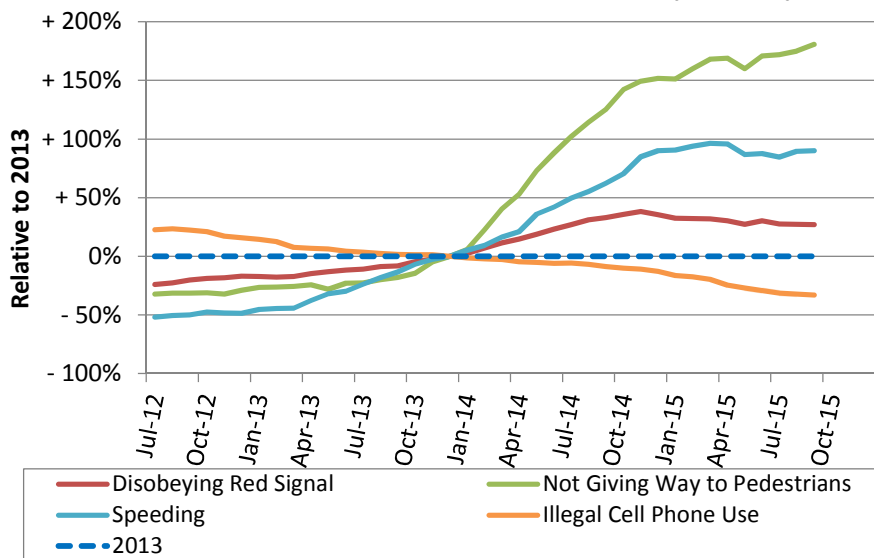


Total Traffic Fatalities in Previous 12 Months

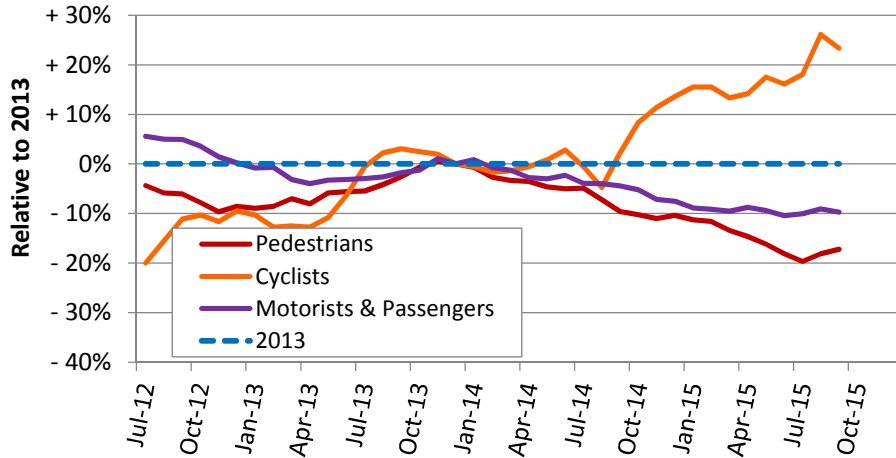

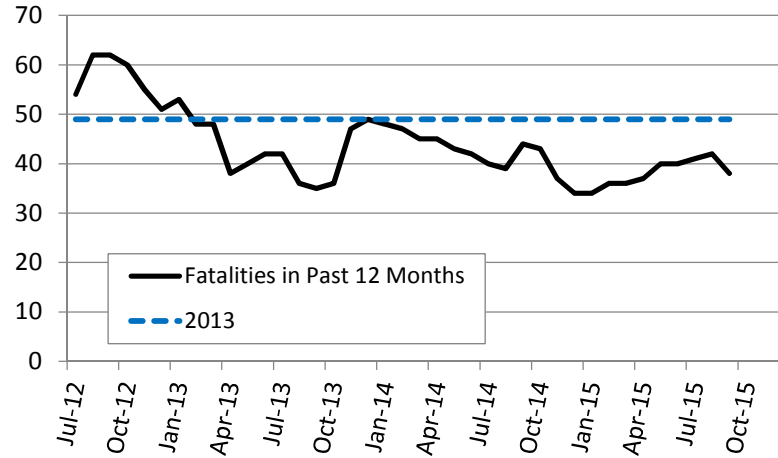

Injuries & Fatalities in Previous 12 Months (vs. 2013)

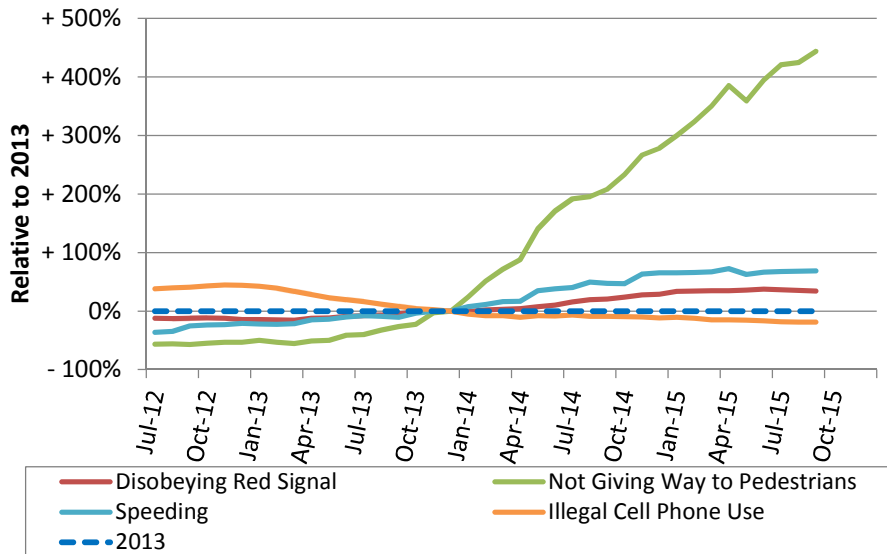


Total Traffic Fatalities in Previous 12 Months

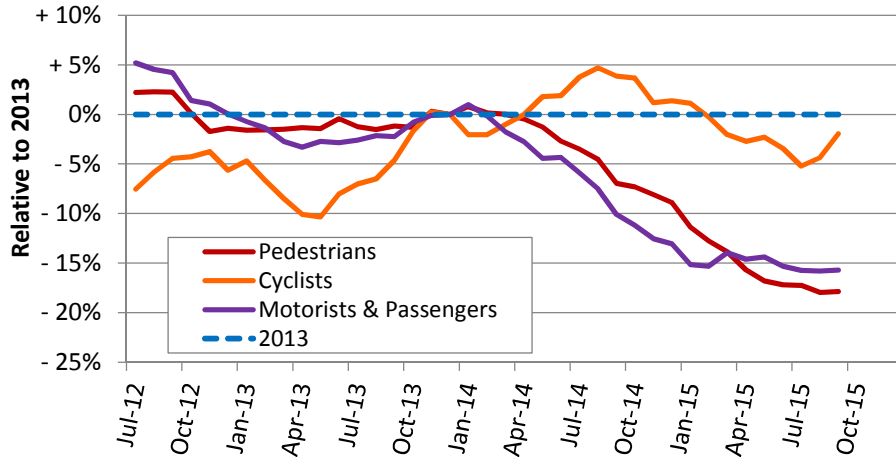

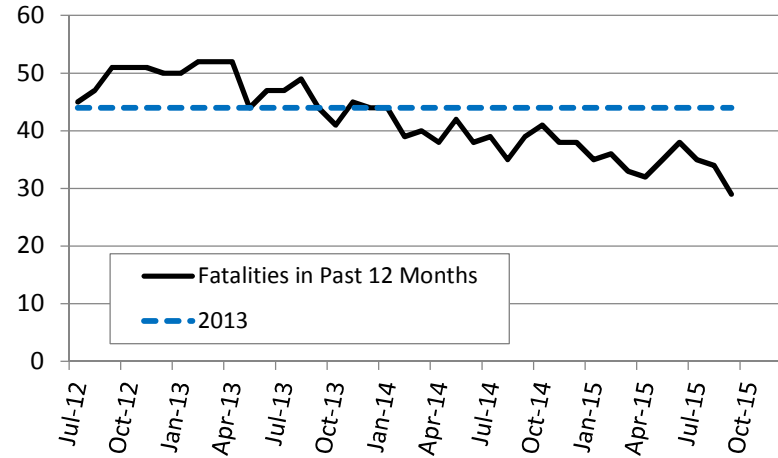

Injuries & Fatalities in Previous 12 Months (vs. 2013)

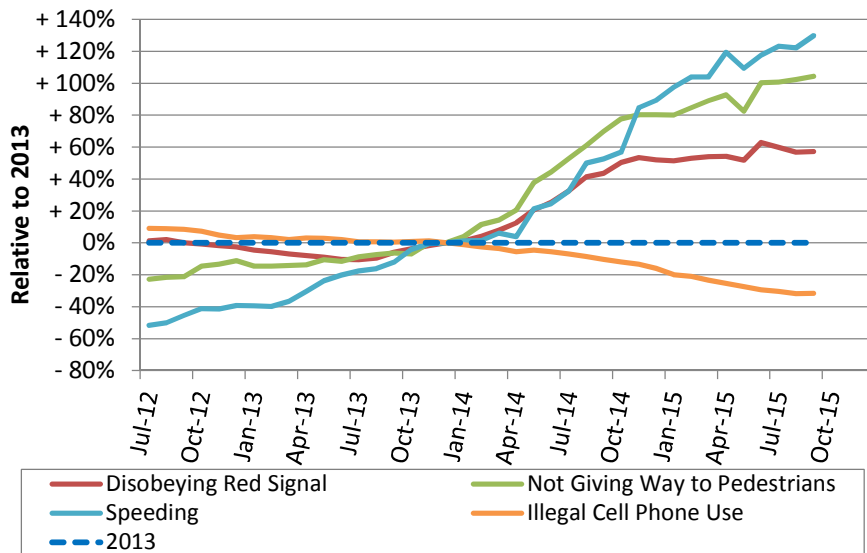


Total Traffic Fatalities in Previous 12 Months

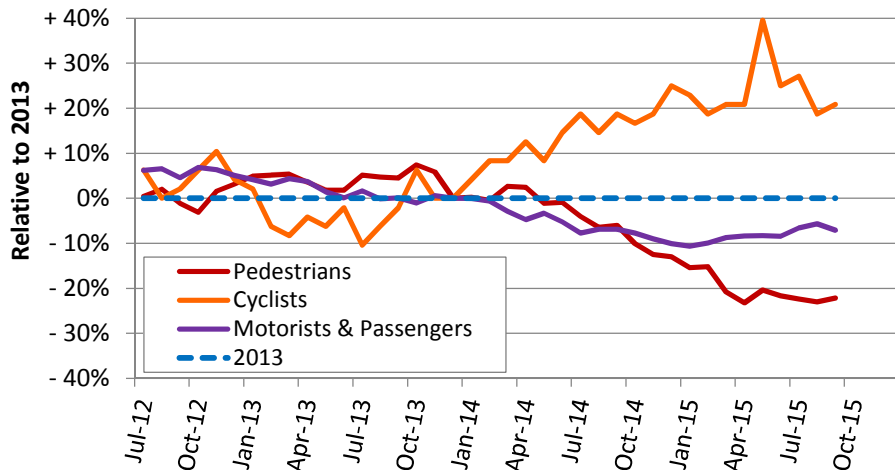

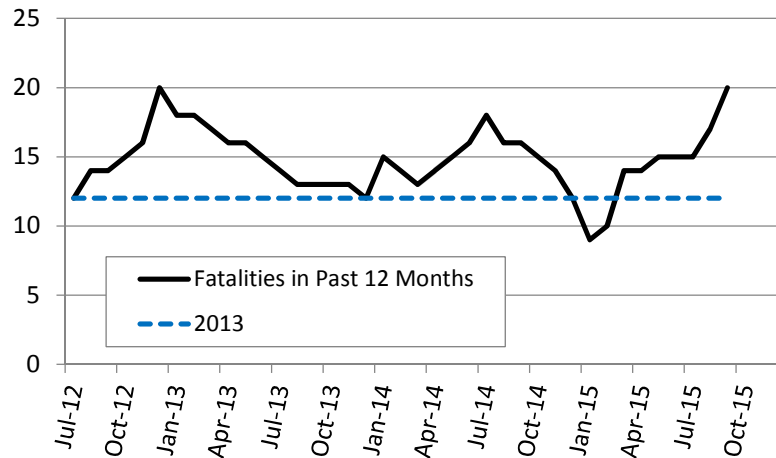

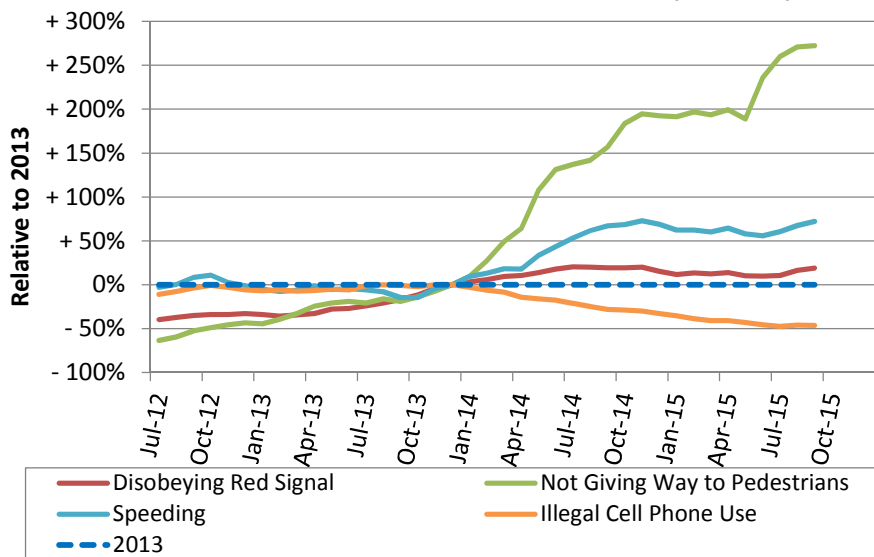


Total Traffic Fatalities in Previous 12 Months

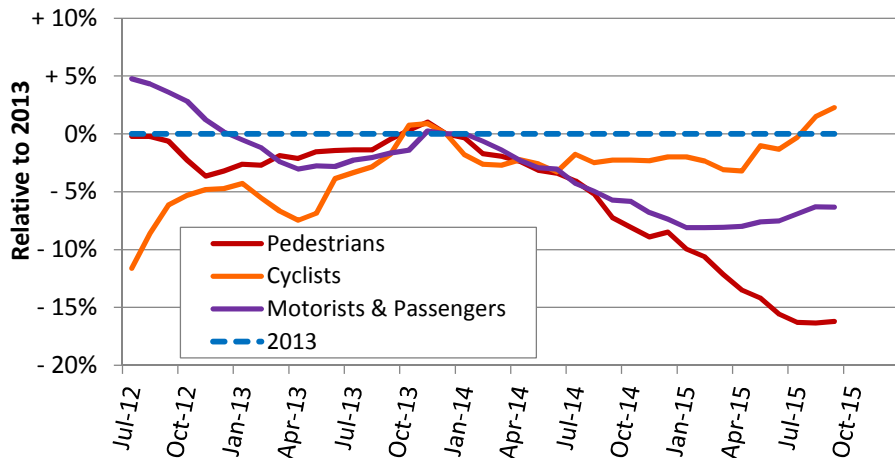

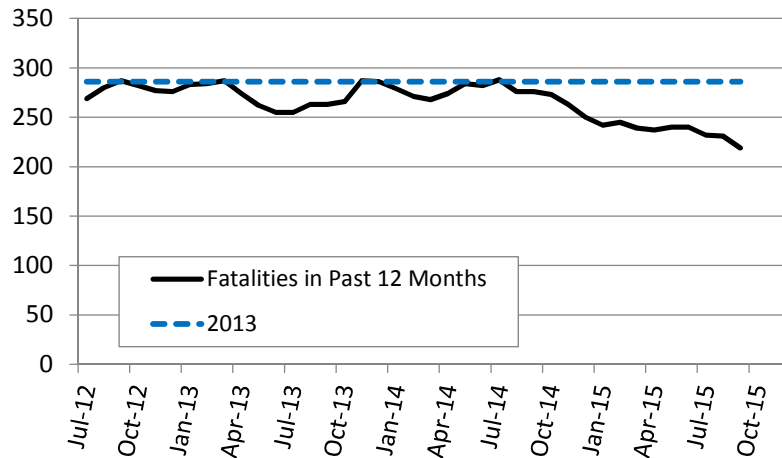

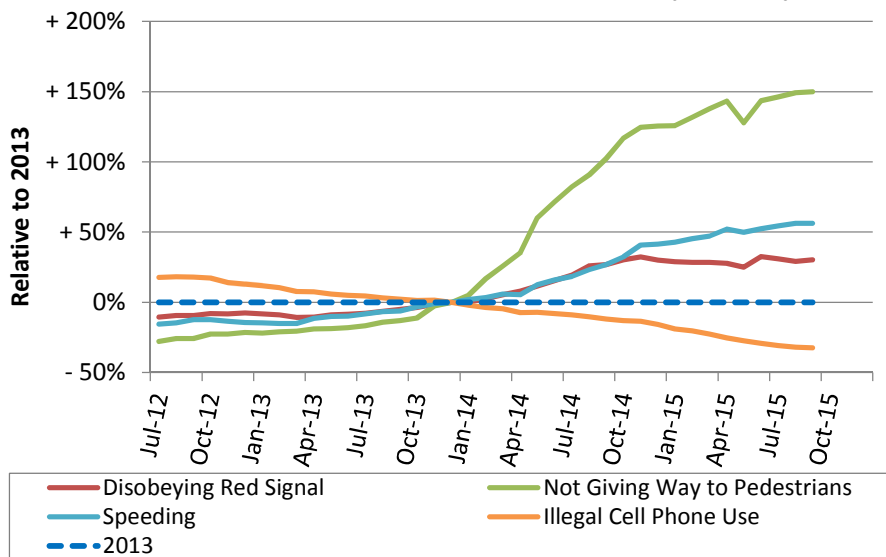


Total Traffic Fatalities in Previous 12 Months

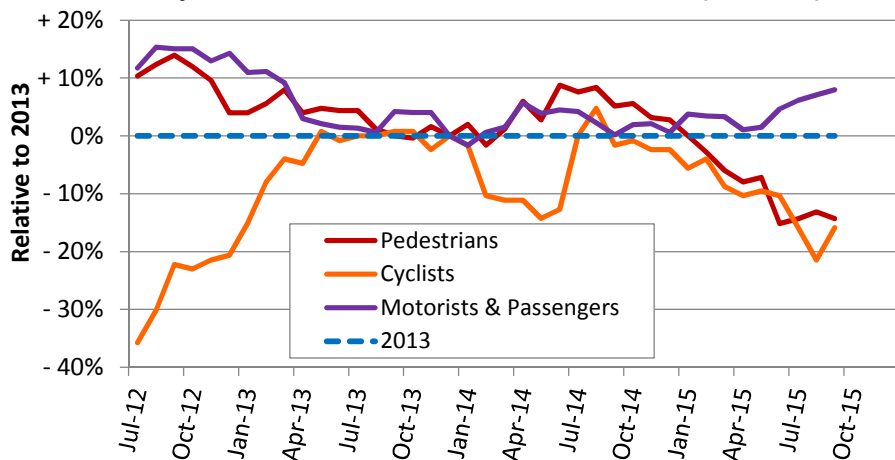

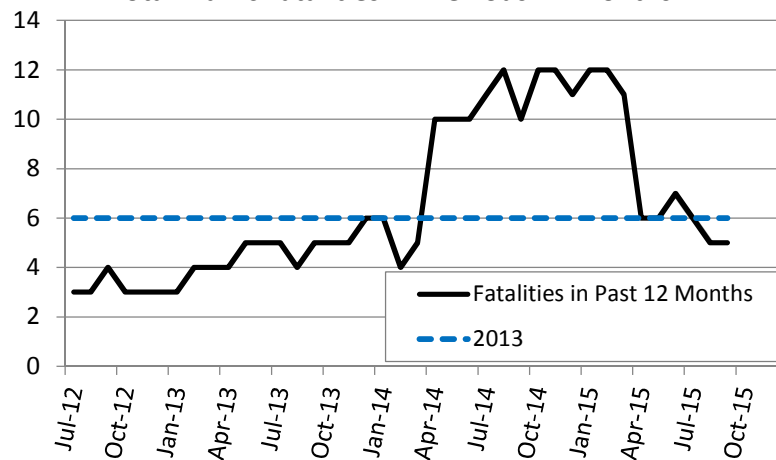

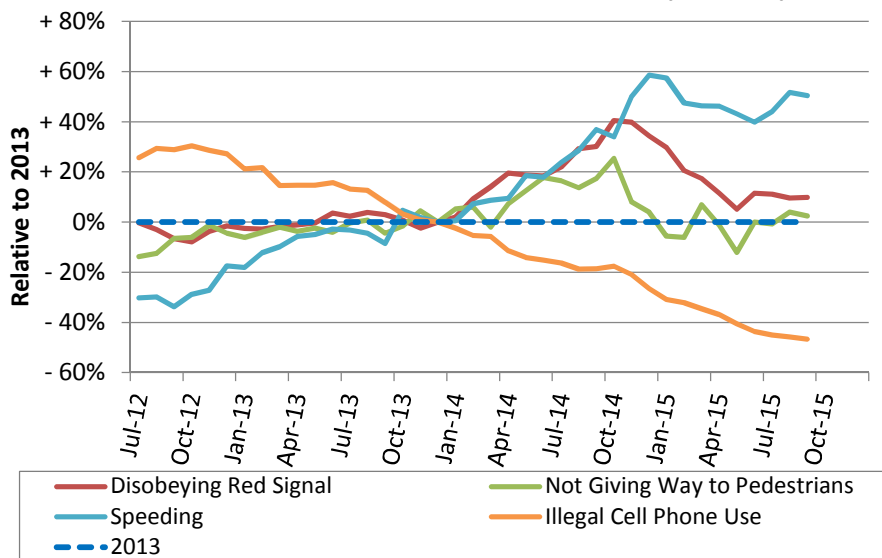


**Total Traffic Fatalities in Previous 12 Months**

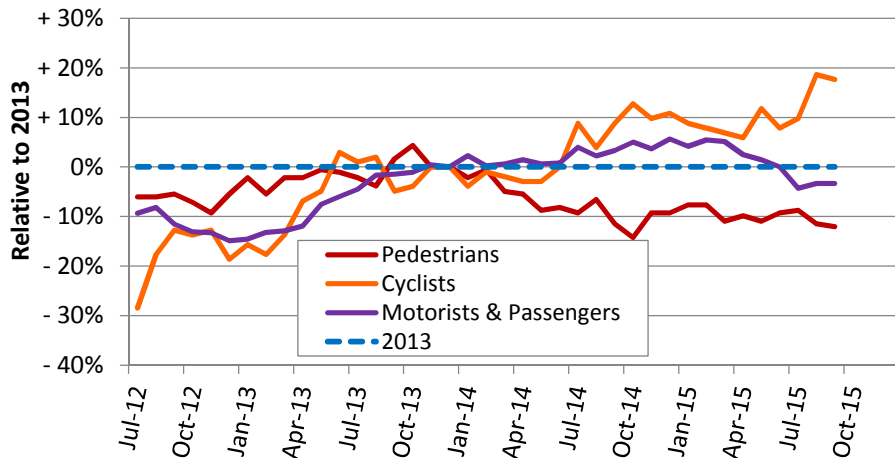

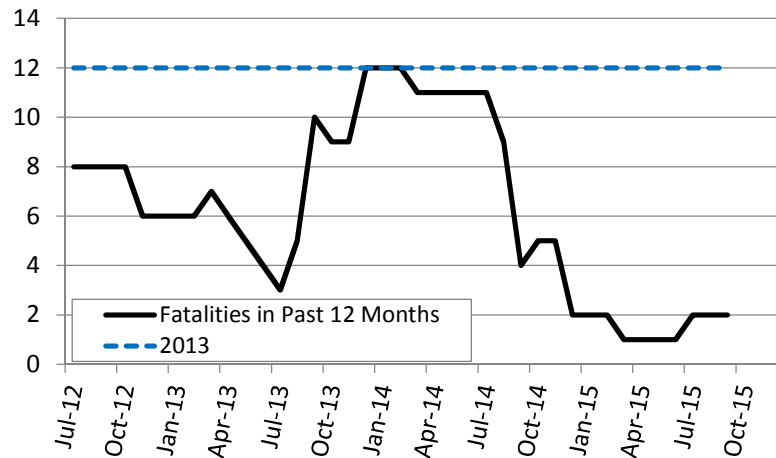

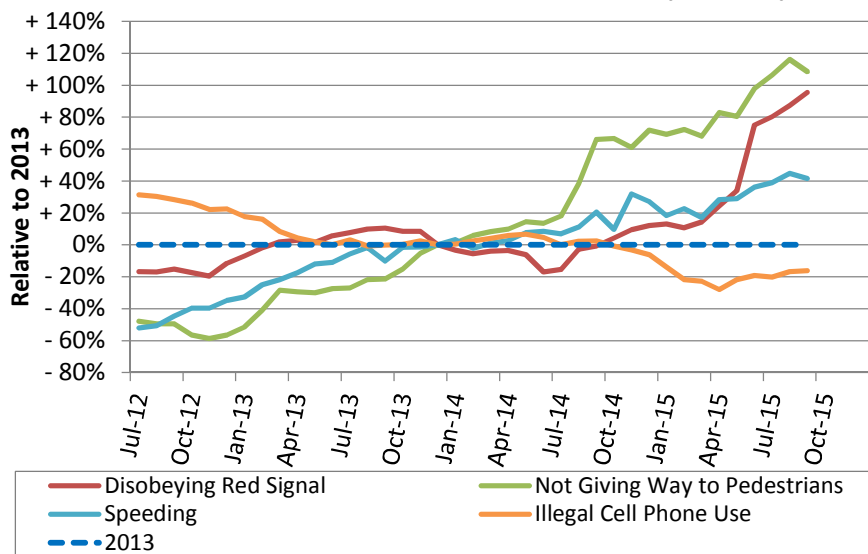


Total Traffic Fatalities in Previous 12 Months

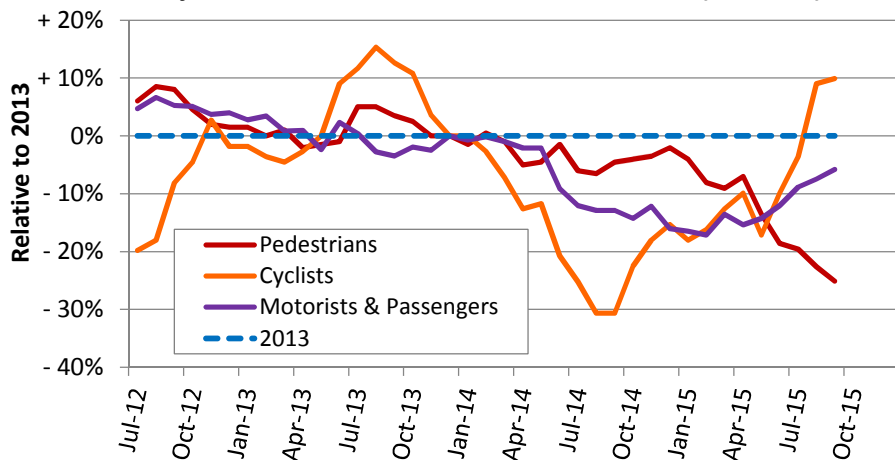

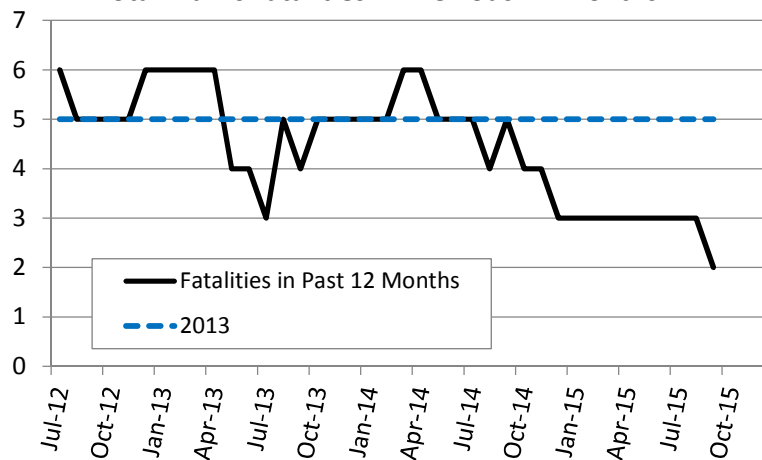

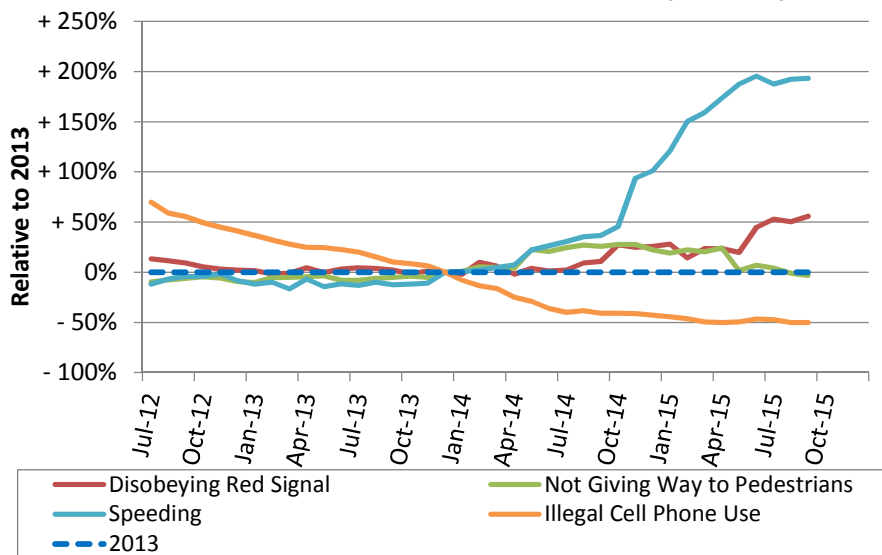


Total Traffic Fatalities in Previous 12 Months

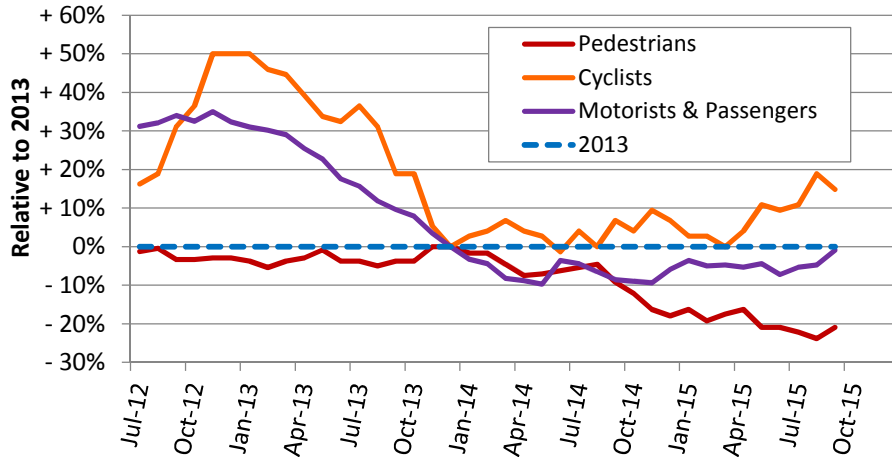

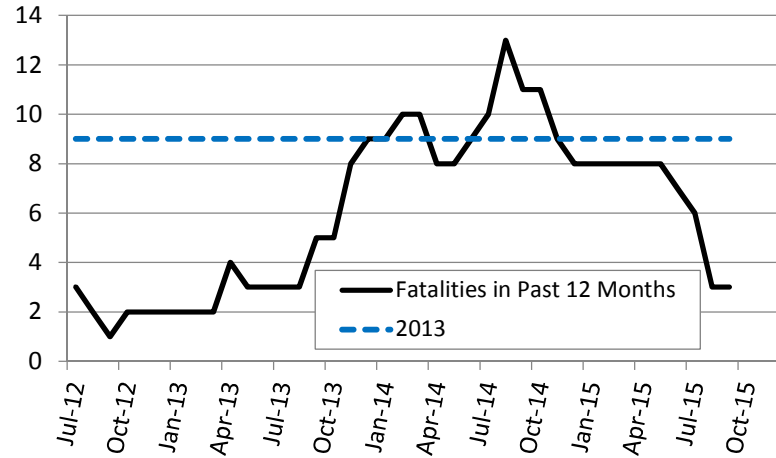

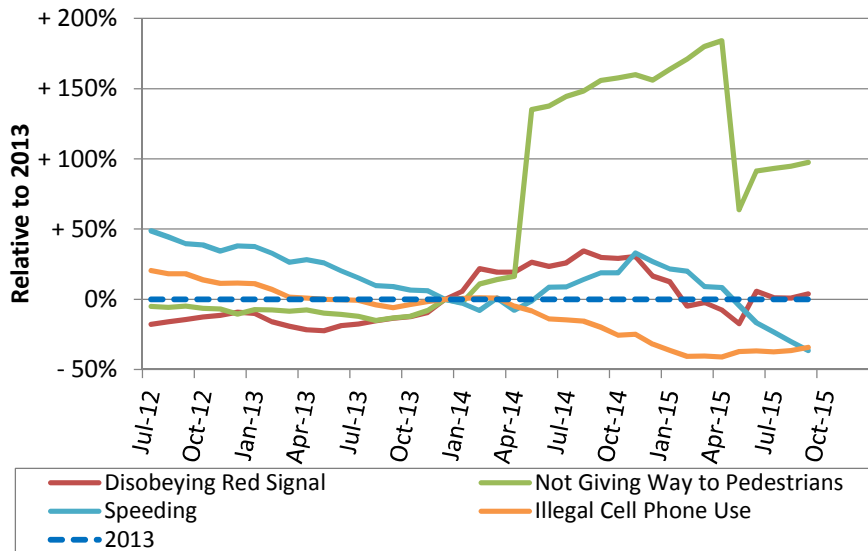


Total Traffic Fatalities in Previous 12 Months

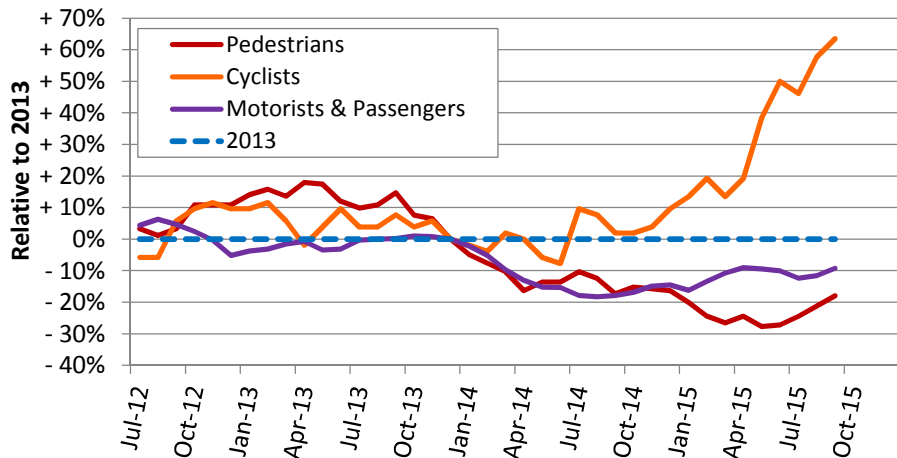

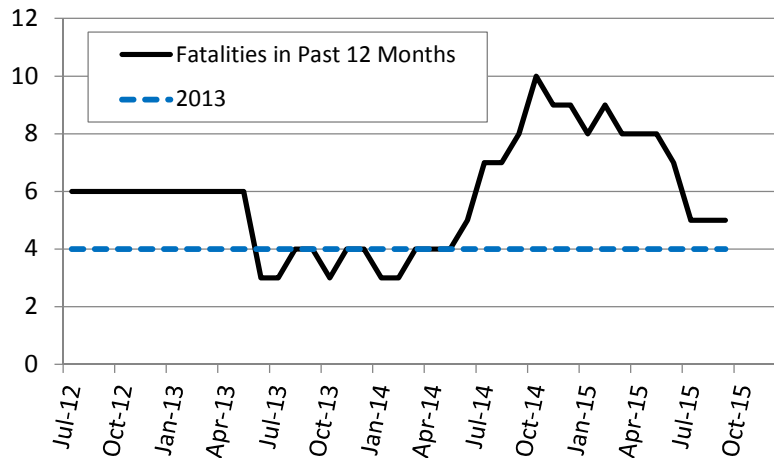

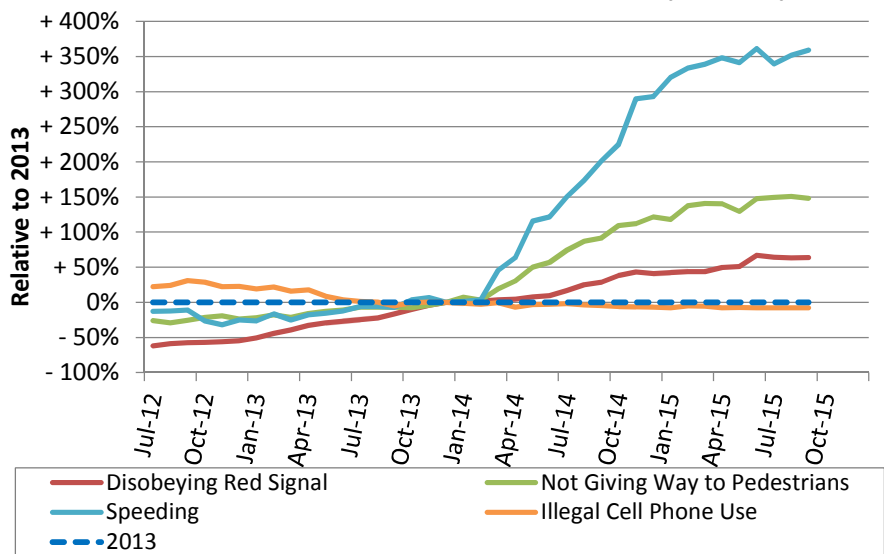


Total Traffic Fatalities in Previous 12 Months

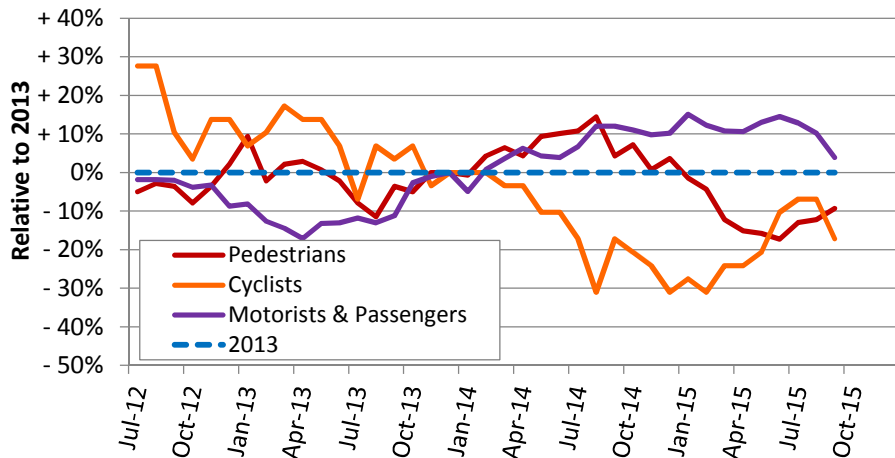

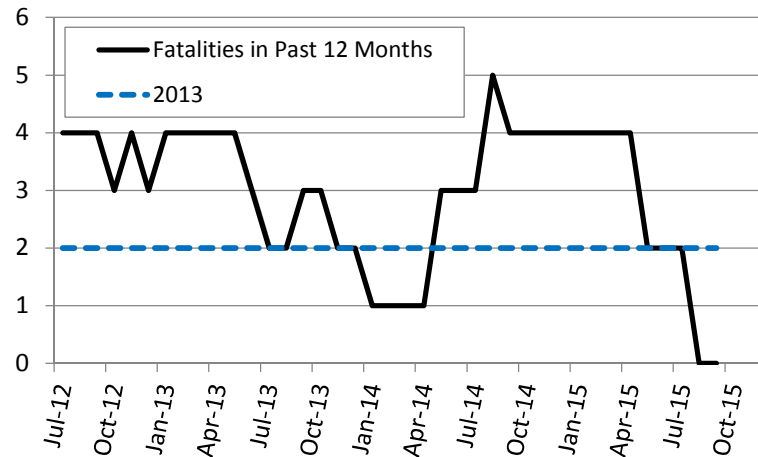

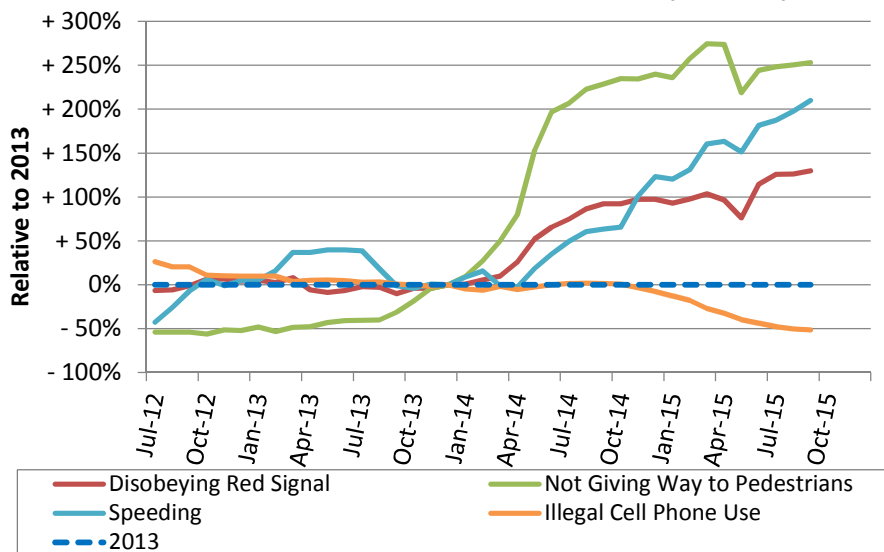


Total Traffic Fatalities in Previous 12 Months

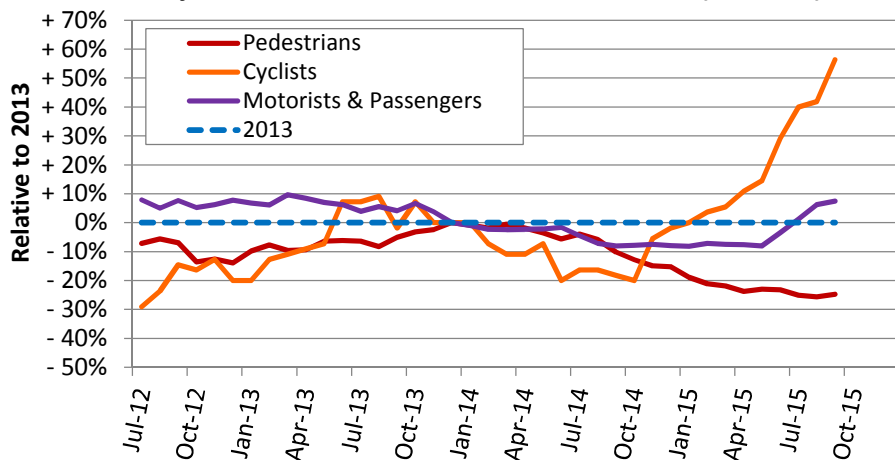

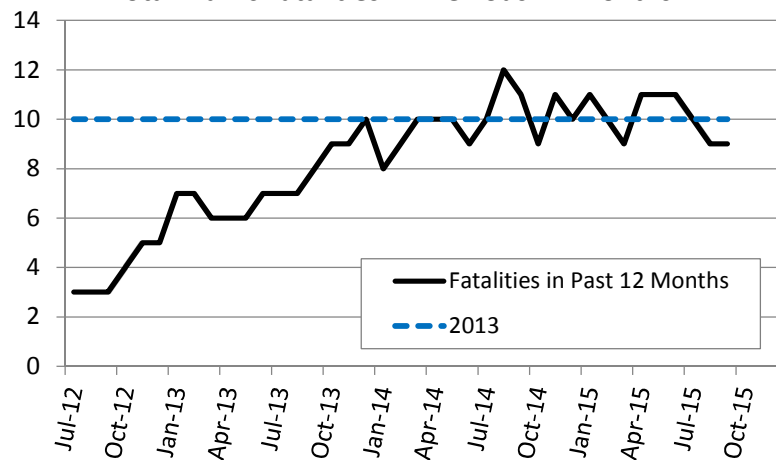

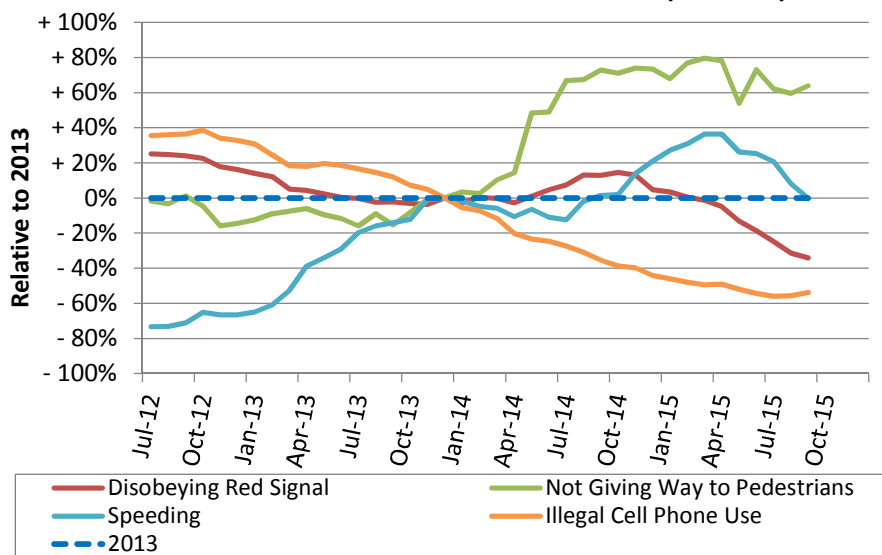


Total Traffic Fatalities in Previous 12 Months

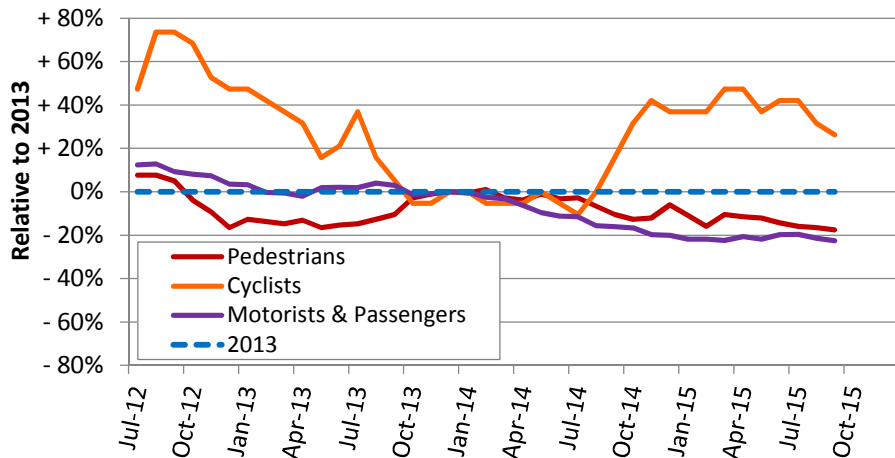

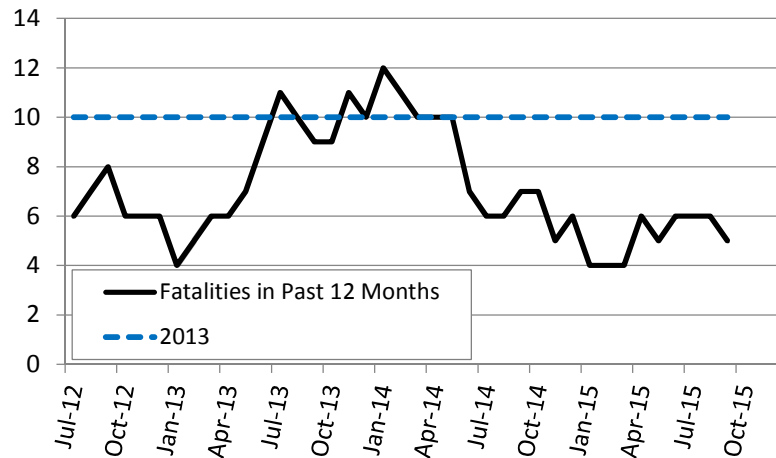

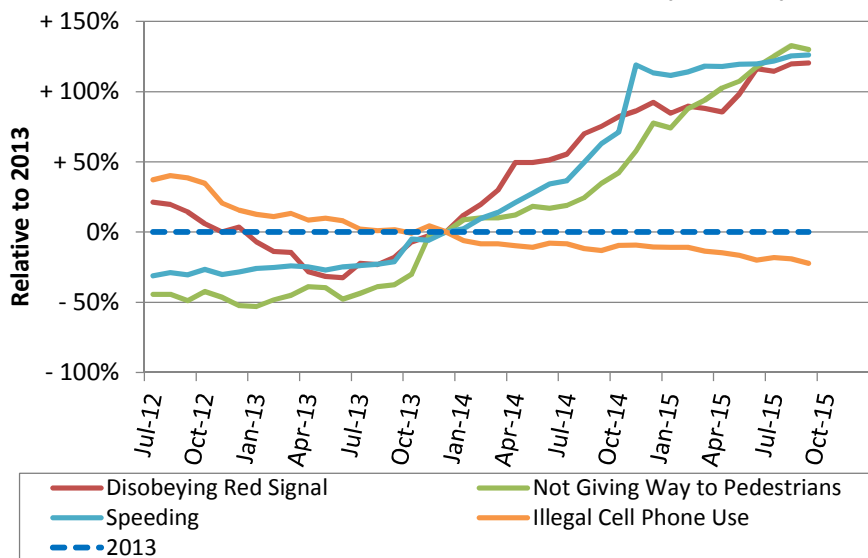


Total Traffic Fatalities in Previous 12 Months

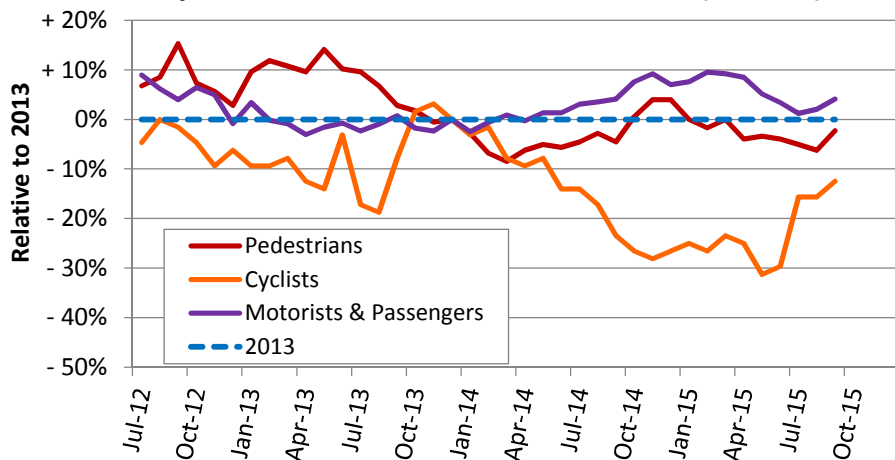

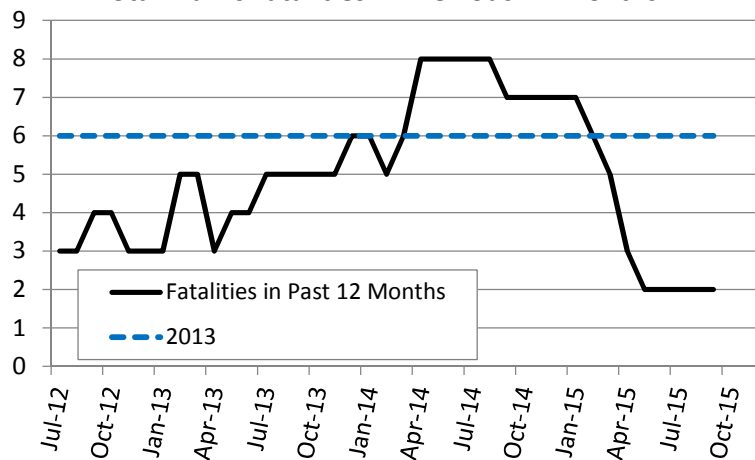

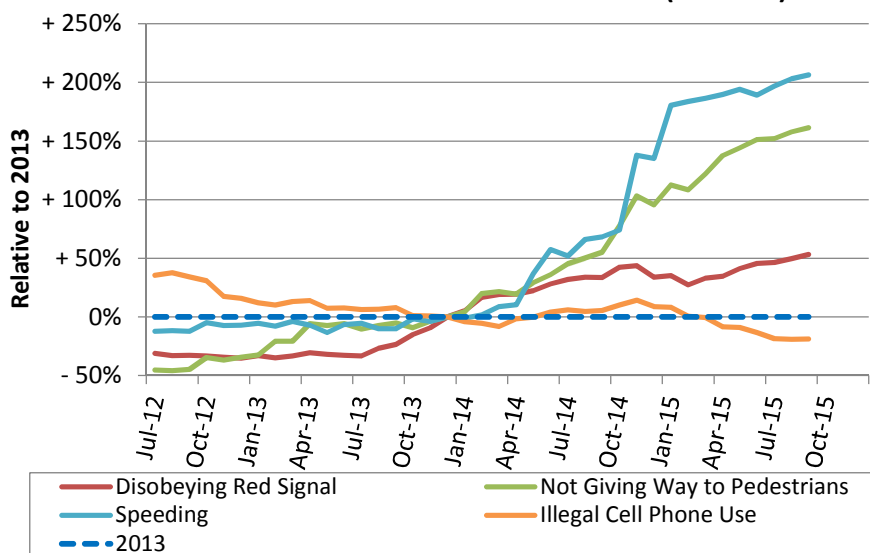


Total Traffic Fatalities in Previous 12 Months

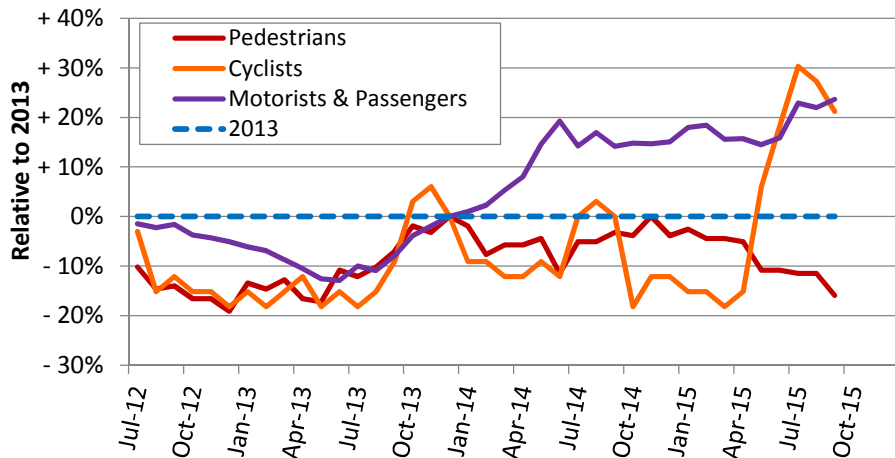

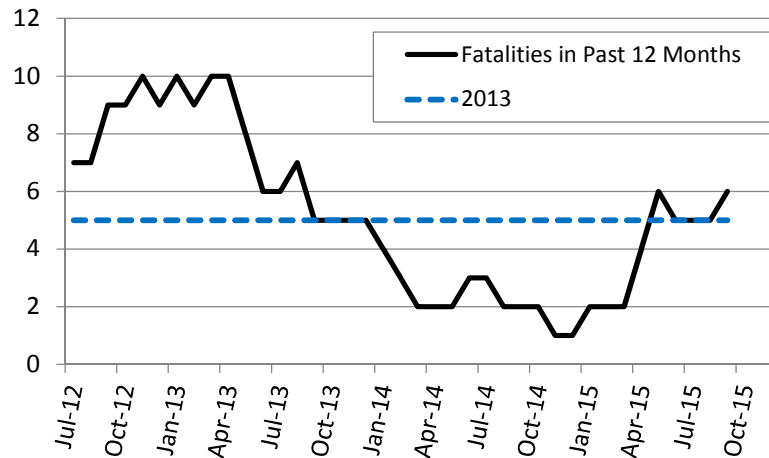

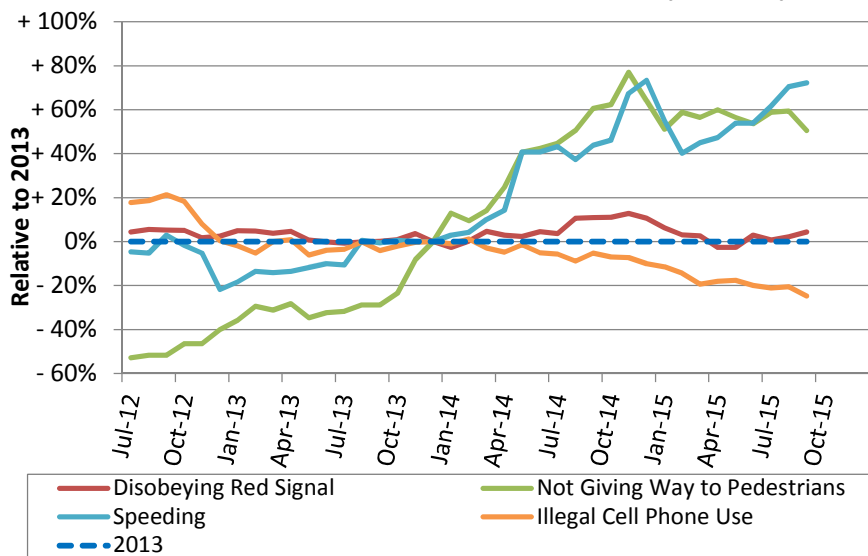


Total Traffic Fatalities in Previous 12 Months

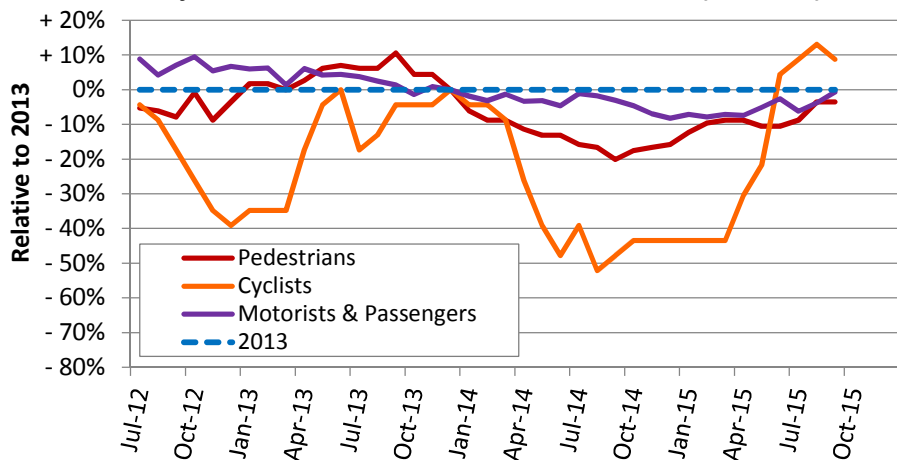

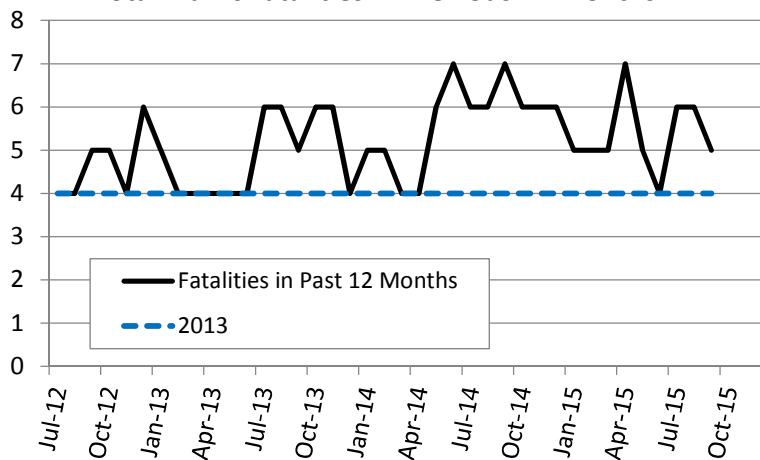

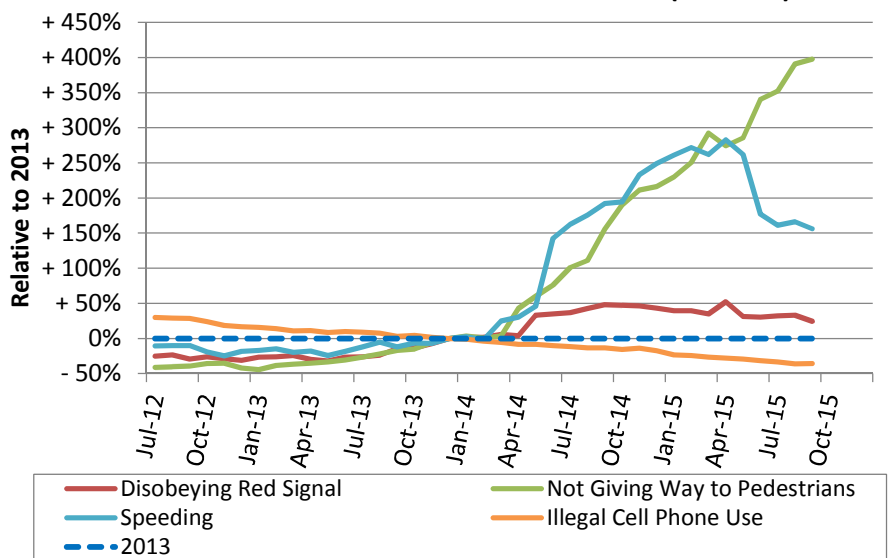


Total Traffic Fatalities in Previous 12 Months

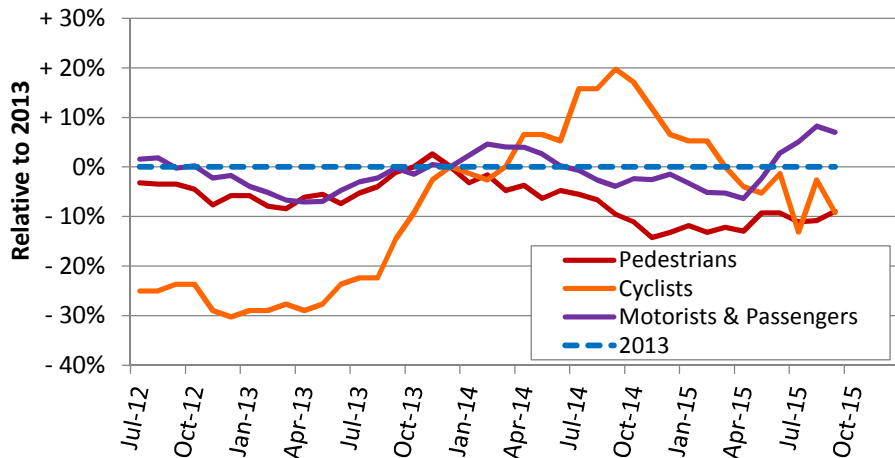

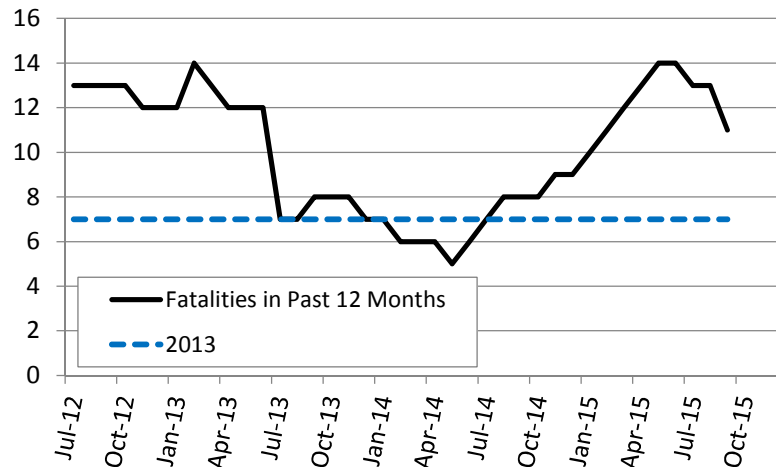

Injuries & Fatalities in Previous 12 Months (vs. 2013)

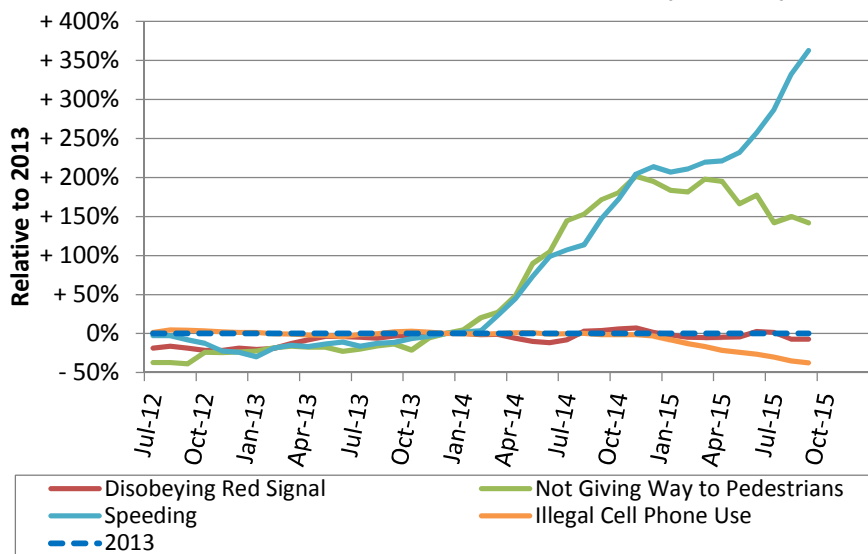


Total Traffic Fatalities in Previous 12 Months

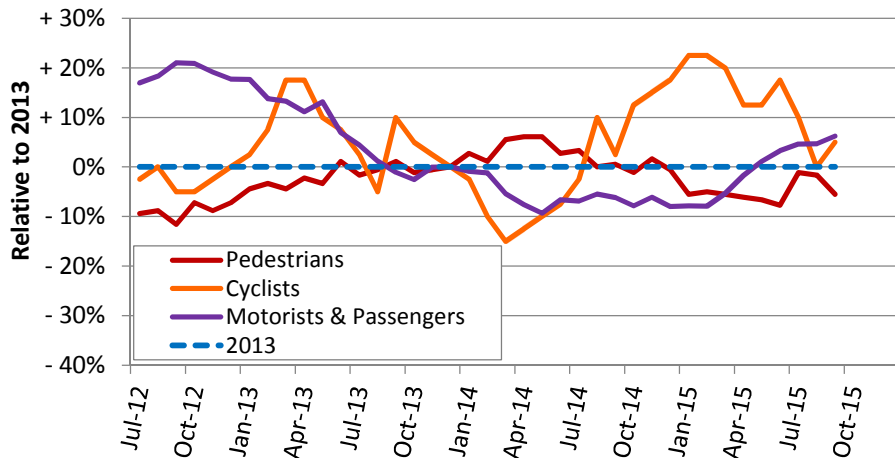

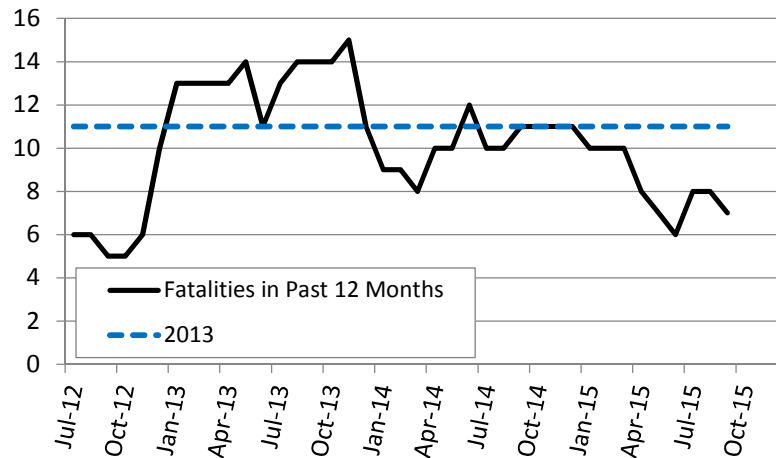

Injuries & Fatalities in Previous 12 Months (vs. 2013)

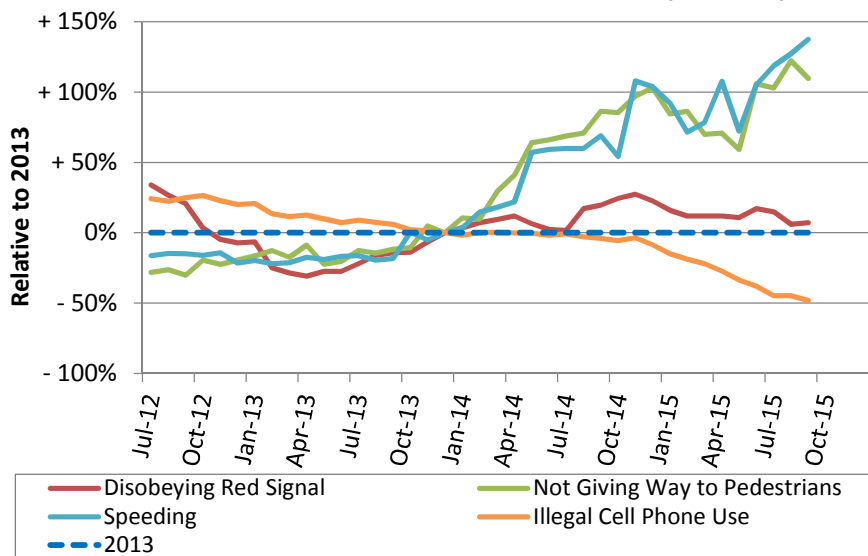


Total Traffic Fatalities in Previous 12 Months

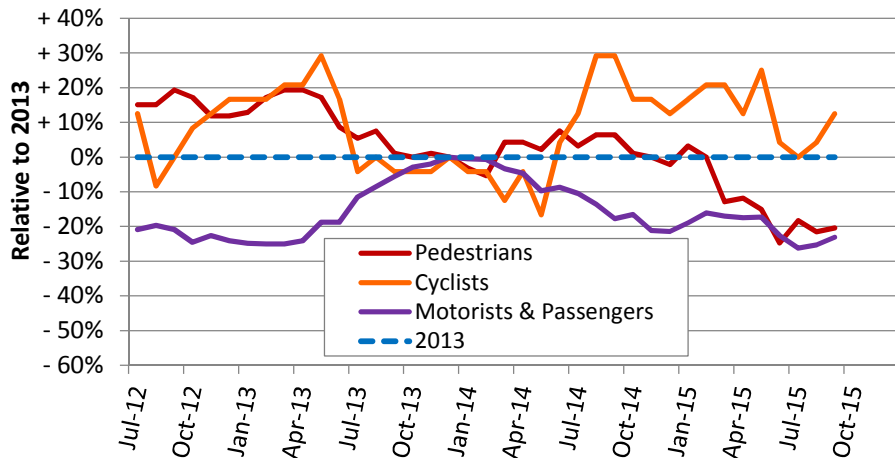

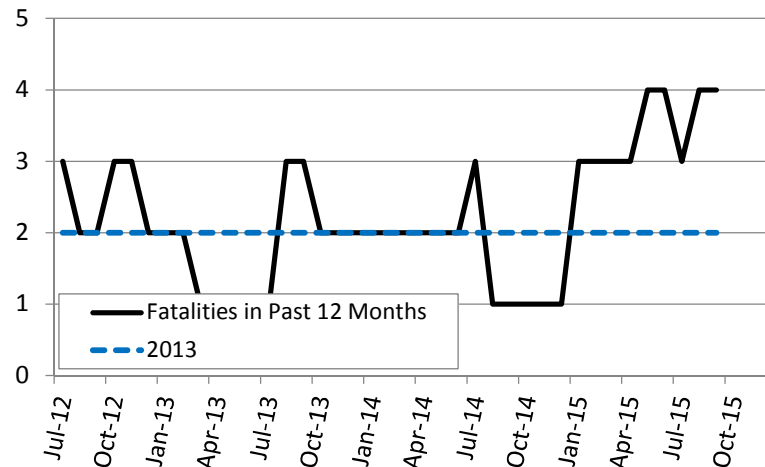

Injuries & Fatalities in Previous 12 Months (vs. 2013)

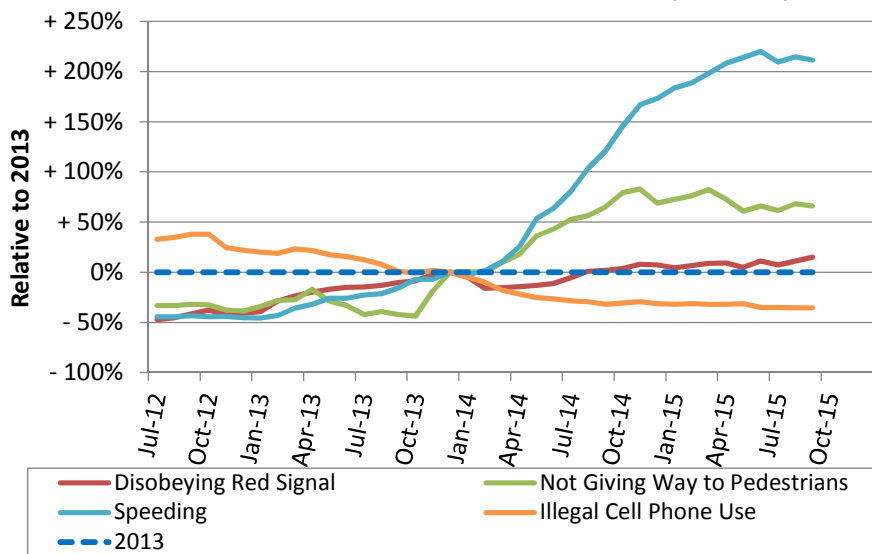


Total Traffic Fatalities in Previous 12 Months
